Safety in numbers

Security for personal identification numbers (PINs)

Schreiner ProSecure now offers an improved solution which reliably indicates tampering with PIN mailers - the PIN Void MultiColor-Label. The multi-colored edge of the label makes it nearly impossible to detach it and to read the secret data below without the recipient noticing the tampering attempt.

The 'PIN Void' MultiColor-Label comes with a void effect which is activated when the label is peeled off the substrate for the first time. The void effect consists of text or a pattern which is preserved even if the label is accurately re-positioned on the mailer to seal the PIN again. The multi-colored design around the label's edge featuring luminous colors and color gradients makes it nearly impossible to conceal the void message or image again by re-coloring it. As additional security elements, the label has integrated edge cuts which destroy it during a peel-off attempt. Access to the secure information below the label is acquired through a scratch-off hologram.
